Leadership & Peace Programme, delivers skills to help counteract radicalism, alleviate mental issues and give support against bullying.

Gives confidence and skills to young people, enabling them to gain the opportunity to be heard and encourages them to speak out.

The Peace Fellows linked in with the Peace Project

Eligibility to become a Peace Fellow:-

- 1) Excellent leadership skills
- 2) A strong commitment to international understanding and peace
- 3) A bachelor's degree or equivalent, plus three years of related full-time work or volunteer experience
