## Financial procedures

Clubs are free to raise funds in any way that they find convenient and effective.

The sponsorship form is for use by individual Rotarians only, funds taken from a clubs Charity account cannot be a Gift Aid donation.

Clubs are requested to collect all monies from Sponsors and pay the cash and cheques into their Club Charity Account.

When all funds have been collected a cheque for the total raised for Wheel Power payable to *Rotary International District 1080 Charitable Trust* should be sent to Rotarian Sally Green, 1 Rembrandt Close, Lowestoft, Suffolk NR32 4LU, together with all sponsorship forms.

When the forms have been checked each club will receive a certificate confirming the amount raised for Wheel Power including any Gift Aid recoverable.

The District Charitable Trust will deal with the Gift Aid Recovery.

Towards the end of the current Rotary year a cheque for the total raised within the district, including the Gift Aid Tax will be presented to Wheel Power for the purchase of special wheel chairs for use by disabled athletes.
